# Remodelling workshops



- In 2006 & 2007 Cams & Portchester clusters took up the offer of remodelling workshops
- The partnerships had to learn to understand and trust each other and find a shared understanding of Extended Services – but the ES path wasn't always clear or easy!
- The two clusters continued to work separately with a shared coordinator until 2009





# ..then came CAPP!



- The joint **Cams and Portchester Partnership (CAPP)** formed **Jan 2009**
- CAPP is 'sub-managed by a small **'Strategic Group'** of **Governors/Head Teachers**
- We are really fortunate that CAPP meetings have had a wide representation from many different organisations and groups – without this partnership - extended services would not have happened ....and...

- We hit **Full Core Offer** targets well ahead of time
- We designed and managed a borough-wide project to support disadvantaged children to access extended services from 2010. From comments, feedback and reports from schools, it appears that **L.E.A.P** has had some excellent outcomes

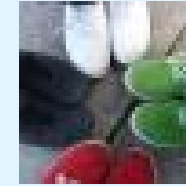
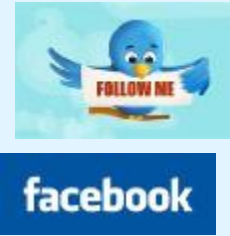


