GET IT ON website publicity

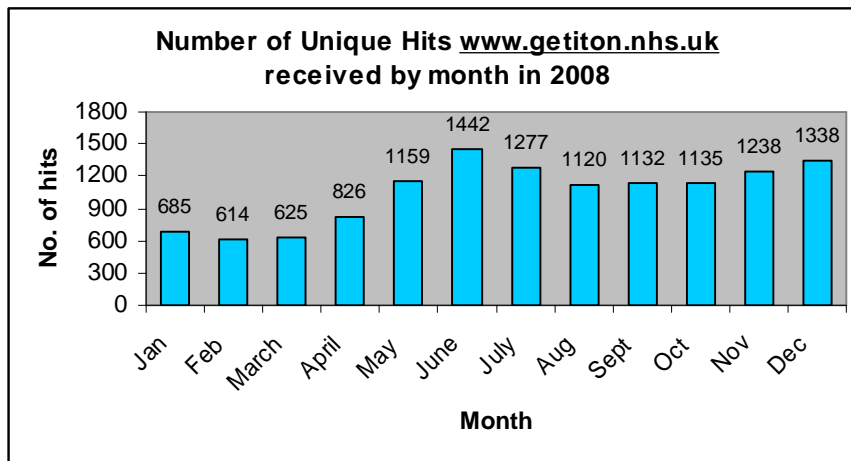

Health in Pregnancy Grant

The government is launching a new initiative for expectant mothers called the 'Health in Pregnancy' grant.

This will be a one-off payment of £190.00 received after week 25 of the pregnancy when specific medical advice has been given by a Doctor or Midwife. This will include advice on healthy living etc. Once this advice has been given, the expectant mother will be given a claim form to claim her £190.00 from HMRC. They will then need to return the claim form within four weeks. The scheme will apply to any pregnant mother who has been given a due date of 6 April 2009 or later. Payments will only start after 6 April 2009.
